SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

I. NASTT's Michael E. Argent Memorial Scholarship Program

The North American Society for Trenchless Technology (NASTT) will provide selected scholarship recipients with tuition funds for the 2010-2011 academic year. Five scholarships of \$5,000 each (total of \$25,000) will be awarded to eligible members of the current NASTT Student Chapters. Students from all academic levels, including freshmen, undergraduates and graduate students, who represent a variety of engineering disciplines and goals, are encouraged to apply.

Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, scholastic honors, work experience, community service, financial needs, goals and aspirations plus, an essay response. Final selections will be made by the 2011 NASTT Scholarship Selection Committee and will be announced on March 1, 2011.

The winning applicants will be awarded \$5,000 U.S. of financial aid for the 2010-2011 school year. Winning applicants must attend the NASTT 2011 No-Dig Conference in Washington, D.C. (March 27 to 31, 2011) to be eligible to receive the scholarship award.

Award payments to the winning applicants will be sent directly to the appropriate educational institution financial aid offices. The scholarship is intended for use as payment of tuition and/or academic fees. Any balance may be credited to a future term tuition and/or academic fees or for expenses directly associated with the academic year.

II. Eligibility

Each applicant **must** be a member in good standing of a current Student Chapter of NASTT and be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college, university or trade school for the 2010-2011 academic year. In order to be considered, applicants must submit their paperwork to the NASTT Executive Director by the **January 10, 2011 deadline**.

III. How to Apply

- Applications may be obtained from the NASTT website at www.nastt.org.
- Applications are to be sent electronically (only) to the NASTT Executive Director.
- Applications that are received late, or are incomplete, will not be considered.
- Applications **must** include an official educational institution transcript.
- Applicants must complete the Personal Details page and the Financial Needs page.
- All applications and supporting documents **must** be received by the NASTT no later than midnight, **January 10, 2011**.
